#### 4.0 **Procedures**:

- 4.1 ESC and ISD staff will implement an intentional and age appropriate rest time or nap period at regular times each day.
  - 4.1.1 Pre-School age children nap time should not exceed 60 minutes.
  - 4.1.2 Toddler age children nap time should not exceed 90 min.
  - 4.1.3 Infants must have a supervised nap period that allows the infant to maintain his own pattern of sleeping and waking periods
- 4.2 Preschool age children are encouraged, but not forced to rest or nap. Infants not yet able to turnover on their own must be placed on their backs in a face up sleeping position in the infant's own crib. Signs will be placed on the cribs of children who can roll over.
- 4.3 Infants are removed from cribs as soon as they wake.
- 4.4 Alternative quiet time learning activities are available for children who do not need or want to rest/nap.
- 4.5 Mats/Cots will be provided for all students during the resting period.
  - 4.5.1 Mats/cots should be placed head to toe.
  - 4.5.2 Mats and cot sheets should be sanitized accordingly.

- 4.6 Adequate lighting is available so that all students can be seen at all times.
- 4.7 Active Supervision is required during this period as teachers should position themselves so that all children are monitored.
