4.0 Procedures:

- 4.1 ESC and Head Start Staff will approach routines like diapering and handwashing, and transitions between activities as opportunities for strengthening development, learning, and growth.
- 4.2 Staff will spend the first several weeks of school teaching routines and procedures to children including washing hands, using the restroom-*See P&P 1302.47(b)(6)*, arrival and dismissal procedures and playground. Review and reteach periodically throughout the year. During times of pandemic, hand washing will be more frequent throughout the day.
- 4.3 The routines and procedures should be modeled, practiced, and scaffolded until children are able to complete tasks independently.
- 4.4 Visual routines and schedules are created and posted together as a class for reference throughout the year.
- 4.5 Children are encouraged to make independent choices and taught the skills needed to care for their own needs.
- 4.6 Planned transitions keep children engaged while they shift from one activity to the next; minimizing long waits in line or sitting and waiting.
 - 4.6.1 Give children 5 minute warning before a transition occurs
 - 4.6.2 Convert transition into a learning activity.
 - 4.6.3 Music and movement activities including songs and fingerplays.
