4.0 **Procedures**:

- 4.1 ESC and ISD Staff will provide a variety of indoor/outdoor, developmentally appropriate materials and equipment, accessible to all children, to promote the development of gross motor skills. During times of pandemic, increased outdoor activities will be encouraged, including the use of outdoor manipulatives that can be easily sanitized.
- 4.2 ESC and ISD Staff will provide a variety of materials in all center areas, accessible to all children, with multi-sensory activities to promote the development of fine motor skills.
- 4.3 ESC and ISD staff will provide an indoor and outdoor environment that is open and friendly for the children to practice skills such as crawling, walking, running, balancing, catching and reaching activities(for infants).
- 4.4 ESC and ISD staff will provide activities and materials that encourage grasping, dropping, pulling, pushing, throwing, touching, and mouthing (for infants).
- 4.5 Children will be provided responsive adult guidance and enough time for completion of activities with success.
- 4.6 ESC and ISD Staff will ensure that materials and activities are inclusive and developmentally appropriate for meeting the needs of all children.

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- 4.7 Active physical development will be enhanced through rhythmic experiences, music, and movement throughout the daily schedule.
- 4.8 Staff will follow the recommendations of the IFSP/IEP when serving children with disabilities.
- 4.9 Children will participate in a minimum of 30 minutes of outdoor physical activity daily. In inclement weather as defined by the local school district, indoor physical activities will be scheduled.
- 4.10 ISD staff will incorporate planned outdoor learning activities in their lesson plans which will encourage rich opportunities for STEM, language, social and nature learning.
- 4.11 Physical activity **will not** be used as a reward or punishment.
