Birth to Three Year Olds**

Early detection and intervention are an important part of serving a child with hearing loss. Families with babies birth to three years old, with an auditory impairment, qualify for services in their home including:

- **Communication and amplification options.**
- **Strategies for building language naturally**
- **Methods for improving listening**
- **Resources for the family**
